## ***Coalition Updates***

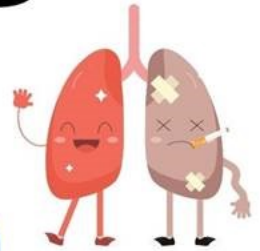

# Smoking Stinks!

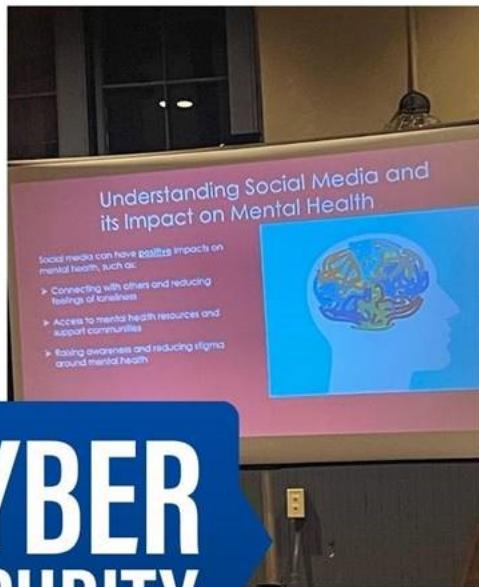
